

**DIRECTIONS TO COLORADO TRAILS RANCH**

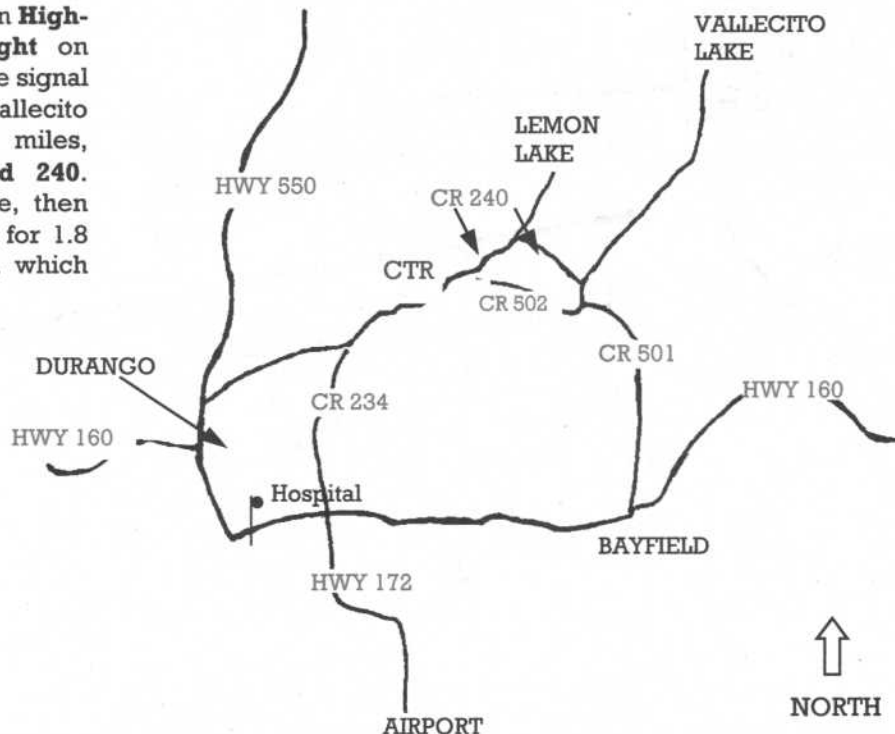
From **Main Avenue** in Durango, turn **east** on to **15th Street**, then **left** on to **County Road 240 (Florida Road)**. There is an Exxon station at the intersection of County Road 240 and County Road 250 as well as a traffic light. Colorado Trails Ranch is 10 miles from this intersection, on County Road **240**. It is on the left hand side of the road. (you will see a lot of white fence).

From **Main Avenue** in north Durango, turn **east** on **32nd Street**. Travel until it ends at **County Road 250**, then turn **right** and travel until it ends at County Road 240 (the Exxon Station will be on the left) and there is a traffic light at the intersection. Turn **left** onto **County Road 240** and travel 10 miles. Colorado Trails Ranch is on the left hand side (you will see a lot of white fence).

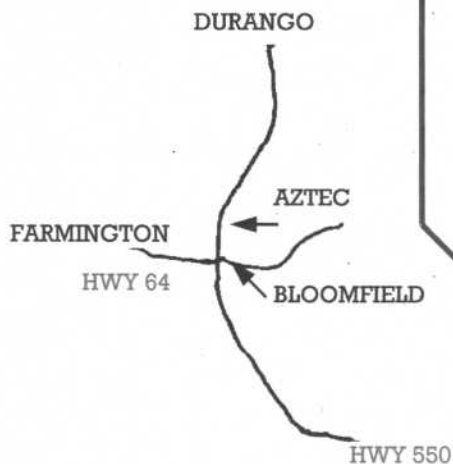

**DIRECTIONS FROM BAYFIELD AND THE EAST**

If you are coming from the east on **Highway 160**, at Bayfield, turn **right** on **County Road 501 (CR 501)** at the signal — as if you are heading to Vallecito Lake. Travel north for about 9 miles, then turn left on **County Road 240**. Travel 2.8 miles, cross a bridge, then turn **left** at the stop sign. Travel for 1.8 miles to Colorado Trails Ranch which will be on the right hand side.



**DIRECTIONS FROM ALBUQUERQUE, NM**



**FROM ALBUQUERQUE:** Head north on I-25 to Bernalillo, then take Highway 550 (used to be Highway 44) north and west to Bloomfield and Aztec. In Aztec, turn right and head to Durango.

**FROM SANTA FE:** Head north on Highway 285/84 to Espanola, then take Highway 84 north to Chama. Turn left onto Highway 64/84 and head to Pagosa Springs (64 turns off, but 84 goes to Pagosa Springs). Turn left on to Highway 160 and head west to Bayfield then follow the above directions from Bayfield.
